RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF NECESSARY DOCUMENTS IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE PIEDMONT HEALTH SERVICES AND SICKLE CELL AGENCY, TO APPLY FOR, AND ACCEPT, IF AWARDED, THE HEALTHY START INITIATIVE GRANT THROUGH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES HEALTH RESOURCES AND SERVICES ADMINISTRATION (FORSYTH COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH)

WHEREAS the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) released a notice of funding opportunity HRSA-19-049 titled, "Healthy Start Initiative: Eliminating Disparities in Perinatal Health";

WHEREAS the request to apply for the grant is in partnership with Piedmont Health Services and Sickle Cell Agency, a non-profit agency in Guilford County; and

WHEREAS Piedmont Health Services and Sickle Cell Agency will be the lead agency and submit the grant application on behalf of the Forsyth County Department of Public Health;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the County Manager and Clerk to the Board to execute, on behalf of Forsyth County, the necessary documents to submit an application for the Healthy Start Initiative grant, in coordination with Piedmont Health Services and Sickle Cell Agency, to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Health Resources and Services Administration; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners that the Chairman or County Manager and Clerk to the Board are hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of Forsyth County, necessary documents to receive grant funds, if awarded, as subgrantee of Piedmont Health Services and Sickle Cell Agency, from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Health Resources and Services Administration to support the Healthy Start Initiative, subject to a pre-audit certificate thereon, by the Chief Financial Officer, where applicable, and approval as to form and legality by the County Attorney.
