ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 25-5, SUBSECTION (3) OF THE FORSYTH COUNTY CODE ENTITLED, "MEETINGS", "VOTING", CHANGING THE WAY A QUORUM IS DETERMINED DURING COMMUNITY APPEARANCE COMMISSION MEETINGS

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Commissioners of Forsyth County, North Carolina as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Sec. 25-5 of the County Code is amended to read as follows:

- (1) Occurrence. The commission shall hold at least eleven (11) meetings per year. All meetings and hearings of the commission shall be open to the public and reasonable notice of the time and place thereof shall be given to the public. Meetings shall be called by the chairman or upon request to him by seven (7) members of the commission.
- (2) Records. The commission shall maintain a record of member attendance, actions taken, findings, and recommendations, which record shall be open to the public.
- (3) Voting. A quorum to do business shall consist of at least eight (8) members a majority of the total filled seats of the commission. Official action by the commission shall require a majority vote of those present. The chairman shall be entitled to vote.
- (4) Operating procedures. The commission is authorized to adopt bylaws, rules, regulations, and operating procedures necessary to conduct the affairs of the commission and not inconsistent with the provisions of the Codes of Forsyth County and the City of Winston-Salem.

<u>Section 2</u>. This Ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.
