SUMMARY OF INFORMATION:			
The Personal Health Services Administrative Area of the Forsyth County Department of Public Health has been awarded \$7,500 in additional grant funding from the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, Chronic Disease and Injury Section, Injury and Violence Prevention Branch to increase prevention strategies to reduce prescription medication and drug overdose.			
Drug overdose deaths in the United States have increased fivefold since 1990, claiming the lives of 27,658 Americans in 2007. Unintentional drug overdose deaths are the leading cause of injury death in the United States. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, heroin-related overdose deaths have increased by 39 percent since 2012. By 2017, unintentional drug overdose deaths will become the leading cause injury death in North Carolina. At least half of all opioid overdose deaths involve a prescription opioid. The grant funds will be used to educate the medical community and for a media campaign about naloxone and medication and drug overdose.			
The additional \$7,500 in non-recurring grant funds will support the Health Department's prevention activities for drug and medication overdose initiatives. The service period for these funds ends May 31, 2017.

#### **EXPLANATION:**
