SUMMARY OF INFORMATION:

Forsyth County has the need to replace the storage area network (SAN) with a centralized storage environment that lowers the total cost of ownership while at the same time supports an extended lifecycle. In addition to the one-time cost of replacing the existing hardware and software, the proposal required pricing for maintenance and support coverage for an initial 3 year term with the opportunity to extend the coverage for 2 additional 3 year terms.

To support these needs, after due advertisement, proposals were received February 24, 2017, for replacement of the current storage area network. A summary of the proposals received are as follows:

After the receipt of proposals, County Staff began the initial evaluation of the proposals received for compliance with the proposal specifications. This review determined that the proposals submitted by 5Nine Data Solutions, Data Network Solutions, Inc., BlueAlly Technology Solutions, LLC (Option 1 and 2), Hewlett Packard Enterprises, DataLink Corporation, and Sirius Computer Solutions, Inc. failed to meet all the proposal specifications.

The remaining proposals were analyzed, scored, and ranked by County Staff based upon several factors including but not limited to overall cost, data migrations, company viability, qualifications, technical ability, cloud storage options, and capacity guarantee.

As a result of this evaluation, it is the recommendation of the County Manager, the Chief Technology Officer, and the Purchasing Director that a contract be awarded to VeriStor Systems, Inc., the lowest responsible, responsive proposer meeting all proposal specifications, to replace the storage area network in the amount of \$499,970.00, which includes the hardware, software, and 3 years of maintenance and support services, plus the right to extend the coverage for maintenance and support services for 2 additional 3 year terms, if the County and vendor agree and provided that funds are made available for this purpose.

WHEREAS, proposals submitted by 5Nine Data Solutions, Data Network Solutions, Inc., BlueAlly Technology Solutions, LLC (Option 1 and 2), Hewlett Packard Enterprises, DataLink Corporation, and Sirius Computer Solutions, Inc. failed to meet all the proposal specifications; and

WHEREAS, the remaining proposals were analyzed, scored, and ranked by County Staff based upon several factors including but not limited to overall cost, data migrations, company viability, qualifications, technical ability, cloud storage options, and capacity guarantee; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the County Manager, the Chief Technology Officer, and the Purchasing Director that a contract be awarded to VeriStor Systems, Inc., the lowest responsible, responsive proposer meeting all proposal specifications to replace the storage area network in the amount of \$499,970.00, which includes the hardware, software, and 3 years of maintenance and support services, plus the right to extend the coverage for maintenance and support services for 2 additional 3 year terms, if the County and vendor agree and provided that funds are made available for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the County Chief Financial Officer has determined that sufficient funds are available to cover the cost of this contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners that a contract to replace the storage area network is hereby awarded to VeriStor Systems, Inc., the lowest responsible, responsive proposer meeting all proposal specifications in the amount of \$499,970.00, which includes the hardware, software, and 3 years of maintenance and support services, plus the right to extend the coverage for maintenance and support services for 2 additional 3 year terms, if the County and vendor agree and provided that funds are made available for this purpose and all other proposals are hereby rejected.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Manager and Clerk to the Board are hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of Forsyth County, a contract to replace the storage area network in the amount of \$499,970.00, as identified herein with VeriStor Systems, Inc., subject to a pre-audit certificate thereon by the County Chief Financial Officer, where applicable, and approval as to form and legality by the County Attorney.
