# RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE 250th ANNIVERSARY OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SURRY COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA

WHEREAS in 1770, several citizens of Rowan County petitioned the colonial legislature to establish a new courthouse because of increased settlement in the northern portion of the county;

**WHEREAS** in April 1771, the colonial legislature approved the formation of Surry County from Rowan County;

**WHEREAS** modern-day Forsyth County was located within the newly established Surry County;

WHEREAS Surry County's first courthouse was located in Richmond, a community located along the Yadkin River, in northwestern Forsyth County;

**WHEREAS** the year 2020-2021 is the Sestercentennial of the formation of Surry County; and

**WHEREAS** Surry County will be celebrating the Sestercentennial from May 2020 until May 2021 with special events and activities;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners recognizes this significant milestone in the history of Surry County and celebrates the shared history between our two counties.
