RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE FOR A 2020 NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION PROGRAM COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) TO PROVIDE HOUSING REHABILITATION SERVICES AND THE EXTENSION OF A PUBLIC WATER LINE (COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVLOPMENT)

WHEREAS residents along Highway 65 east of Rural Hall do not have access to public water, which damages their quality of life and lowers their house values;

WHEREAS the Forsyth County Community and Economic Development Department is proposing to provide public water service to 25 low- or moderate-income households by constructing an extension of an 8-inch public water line along Highway 65 (Rural Hall-Germanton Rd) extending east from the town limits of Rural Hall for approximately 2.5 miles and terminating at Abshire Road; and

WHEREAS, in order to fund this construction, the Department plans to pursue various sources of funds, and seeks to submit an application to the North Carolina Department of Commerce for a 2020 Neighborhood Revitalization Program Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) in the amount of \$750,000 which will be used to provide housing rehabilitation services to between 5-10 low- or moderate-income households, as well as provide partial financing for the extension of a 8-inch public water line along Highway 65;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman or the County Manager and Clerk to the Board or their designees to submit a grant application to the North Carolina Department of Commerce for a 2020 Neighborhood Revitalization Program Community Development Block Grant in the amount of \$750,000 to provide housing rehabilitation services to between 5-10 low- or moderate-income households, as well as the extension of a public water line, subject to a pre-audit certificate thereon by the County Chief Financial Officer, if applicable, and approval as to form and legality by the County Attorney.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE is hereby given that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing on Thursday, July 2, 2020 at 2:00 p.m. The public hearing will be conducted remotely, as allowed by the Board's Remote Participation Policy during this state of emergency.

There will be no meeting place where members of the public can be physically present. The Meeting will be broadcast live at 2:00 p.m. on local cable channel WSTV 13-The Government Channel, https://wineo.com/forsythcountync.

The County plans to apply for a 2020 Neighborhood Revitalization Program Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) from the NC Department of Commerce. This is the second public hearing that is required under the CDBG requirements. The grant will be used to provide housing rehabilitation services for low and moderate income homeowners and finance an extension of an 8" public water line along Highway 65 (Rural Hall-Germanton Rd) extending east from the town limits of Rural Hall for approximately 2.5 miles and terminating at Abshire Road. This area is located adjacent to the town limits of Rural Hall. The County will be applying for a grant in the amount of \$750,000. The total project cost is estimated to be \$3,020,000.
