# RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT FY2020 CORONAVIRUS EMERGENCY SUPPLEMENTAL PROGRAM FUNDING FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE (FORSYTH COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE)

WHEREAS the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, is providing funding to local governments to prevent, prepare for and respond to the coronavirus pandemic;

WHEREAS Forsyth County is eligible to receive \$79,054 in FY2020 Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Program funds; and

WHEREAS the Forsyth County Sheriff's Office proposes to purchase an evidence scanner to reduce handling of potentially viral-contaminated materials (\$36,500.00), twenty (20) in-vehicle prisoner partition transport systems (with transport seats) that confines potential viral pathogens and allows for more effective cleaning (\$30,100), Field OPS Mobile Device Application that will immediately send a CAD notification to on-duty and on-call officers of a disaster or other emergency on their County-issued mobile device (\$10,000), and specialty personal protective equipment (PPE) such as gloves, gowns, masks, bio-hazard disposal bags, CPR masks, safety glasses or 5.11-type carrying bag, etc. (\$2,454);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners that the Chairman or County Manager and Clerk to the Board are hereby authorized to execute necessary documents, on behalf of Forsyth County, to apply for and accept FY2020 Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Program funds from the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance in the amount of \$79,054, subject to pre-audit certificate thereon by the County Chief Finance Officer, if applicable, approval as to form and legality by the County Attorney, and further subject to compliance with the applicable bidding laws.

With the funds the Sheriff's Office proposes to purchase an evidence scanner to reduce handling of potentially viral-contaminated materials (\$36,500.00), twenty (20) in-vehicle prisoner partition transport systems (with transport seats) that confines potential viral pathogens and allows for more effective cleaning (\$30,100), Field OPS Mobile Device Application that will immediately send a CAD notification to on-duty and on-call officers of a disaster or other emergency on their County-issued mobile device (\$10,000), and specialty personal protective equipment (PPE) such as gloves, gowns, masks, biohazard disposal bags, CPR masks, safety glasses or 5.11-type carrying bag, etc. (\$2,454).

No local matching funds are required.

The Grant Projects Ordinance Amendment appropriates the FY2020 Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Program Grant funding, in the amount of \$79,054, into the Justice Assistance Grant Projects Ordinance.
