How this plant sale works:

1. Decide on the plants you would like to purchase.
2. Complete this order form and mail it OR visit <http://forsyth.cc/CES/> to place your order on-line.
3. Mail your payment by Friday, February 15th to Forsyth County 4-H, 1450 Fairchild Road, Winston-Salem, NC 27105. Make checks payable to: **Forsyth County 4-H.**
4. On Thursday, March 10 or Friday, March 11 between 8:30 AM and 6:00 PM, you pick up your plants at the Agriculture Building at 1450 Fairchild Road, Winston-Salem.
5. Forsyth County 4-H members use the proceeds from the plant sale to attend 4-H events and to support their 4-H project work in the form of scholarships.

PLANT INFORMATION

ASPARAGUS - Bare root

Jersey Supreme: Uniform spear size, high yield, early, cold tolerant, resistant to rust and fusarium with good flavor.

BLACKBERRIES - Bare root

Kiowa: World's largest blackberry, sweet, heavy producer, has thorns.

Navajo: Thornless, late season ripening, sweetest, small berry, stores well.

BLUEBERRIES - At least two varieties should be planted to insure pollination

Legacy: Southern High Bush: Mid to late season ripening, mid to large light blue fruit, upright growth, good size and quality.

Climax: Early ripening, produces medium-size berries with sweet flavor. Plants are upright with intense green foliage.

Premier: Early to mid season ripening, large great tasting fruit, highly productive, light blue in color. Upright plant with good foliage.

Powder Blue: Late season ripening, highly productive with medium to large sweet fruit, darker in color. Upright plant with good foliage.

Tifblue: Mid season ripening, medium to large berry, light blue in color. Upright, vigorous growing with best fall ornamental color.

FIGS - Bare root, 2 year old stock

Kadota: sweet, brown fig with white flesh. Very cold hardy (down to -10).

GRAPES - Bare root, 2 year old stock

Mars: Very disease resistant, sweet blue seedless fruit, good table fruit.

Himrod: Highly productive, white seedless, good table fruit.

RASPBERRIES - Bare root August-October Ripening

Caroline: Large, extremely productive, intense flavor - extra sweet fruit. Root rot tolerant.

Heritage: Large, ever-bearing, bright red berry, disease resistant, vigorous, winter hardy, excellent for jam.

RHUBARB—Bare root

Ruby Red: Candy-apple red stems with dark green, red-veined leaves for baby leaf or bunching.

STRAWBERRIES - Bare root

Chandler: Mid season, high yield, very large berry, grown by many local commercial growers.

Earliglow: Early season, medium size berry, excellent for eating and freezing.

HERBS - Our plants are grown by a local grower with the reputation of growing beautiful healthy plants.

BLUE BIRD HOUSE -Front opening house with nesting box ready for mounting to a tree or wooden post OR to hang on a 1" board.

Directions to Agriculture Building:

From I-40 West or East - take 52 N to the 25th/28th St. Exit 111A. At the traffic signal at the end of the exit ramp, turn left onto Cleveland Avenue, at the next traffic signal turn right onto Liberty Street then at the next traffic signal turn right onto Fairchild Rd. The Agriculture Building is ½ mile on the right.

From 52 S, from Mt. Airy - take Akron Dr. Exit 112. At the traffic signal, turn left onto Akron Dr. Go to traffic signal at Liberty St. and turn right onto

Liberty St. Go to 2nd traffic signal and turn left onto Fairchild Rd. The Agriculture Building is ½ mile on the right.
