### Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS)

- YRBSS was produced by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and modified to meet the needs of North Carolina.
- Statewide, North Carolina Healthy Schools administers the YRBS to a select sample of North Carolina middle and high school students.
- It is conducted every two years to assess health risk behaviors that contribute to some of the leading causes of morbidity and mortality in youths

### **Purposes of the YRBS**

Focus the nation on behaviors among youth causing the most important health problems
Assess how risk behaviors change over time
Provide comparable data

Behaviors That Contribute to the Leading Causes of Morbidity & Mortality

Unintentional injuries and violence
Tobacco use
Alcohol and other drug use
Sexual behaviors
Unhealthy dietary behaviors
Inadequate physical activity

### **Impact of Sexual Behaviors**

- In 2008, 781 pregnancies occurred in Forsyth County & 19, 398 pregnancies in North Carolina among women aged 15-19 years.
- 990 cases of sexually transmitted diseases were reported among persons aged 10-19 years in Forsyth County and 17,887 cases in North Carolina, in 2008.
- In 2008, 3 cases of HIV Disease were diagnosed among persons aged 10-19 years in Forsyth County and 90 cases in North Carolina.
